Final Pathologic Diagnosis

- 1) Parathyroid adenoma, right upper parathyroid.
- 2) Parathyroid tissue, portion of clinically normal right lower parathyroid.
- 3) Parathyroid adenoma, left upper parathyroid.
- 4) Parathyroid tissue, portion of clinically normal right lower parathyroid.

Gross Description

The specimen is received in formalin in four parts, labeled with the patient's name.

- 1) Designated 'right upper parathyroid adenoma'. It consists of an oval 1.9 x 1.3 x 0.4 cm, 1.090 gram encapsulated portion of soft, tan-red tissue, which is bisected and entirely submitted in one cassette.
- 2) Designated 'portion of clinically normal right lower parathyroid'. It consists of a 0.004 gram portion of soft, pink-tan tissue, which is submitted in toto in one cassette.
- 3) Designated 'left upper parathyroid adenoma'. It consists of an oval 0.9 x 0.7 x 0.2 cm 0.156 gram portion of soft, pink-tan tissue, which is submitted in toto in one cassette.
- 4) Designated 'portion of clinically normal left lower parathyroid'. It consists of an oval 0.006 gram portion of soft, pink-tan tissue, which is submitted in toto in one cassette.
